Itinerary

Day 1: Siem Reap Arrival - Angkor Wat Sunset

Morning

Arrive in Siem Reap, where your English-speaking guide will welcome you at the airport and transfer you to your hotel for check-in.

Standard check-in time is **14:00**; early check-in is available upon request (please contact your travel consultant in advance). The rest of the morning is free for you to relax and refresh before your sunset experience at

Angkor Wat.

Afternoon

Head out in the late afternoon to explore the legendary [Angkor Wat](#), the world's largest religious monument and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Discover its impressive temple-mountain design, symbolizing Mount Meru, and admire intricate carvings and bas-reliefs depicting Hindu mythology and Khmer history, built in the early 12th century under King Suryavarman II.



As the day winds down, enjoy a breathtaking sunset over Angkor Wat - one of Southeast Asia's most iconic and unforgettable travel moments.

After your visit, return to your hotel and relax, getting ready for the adventures ahead.

Day 2: Siem Reap - Angkor Temple Exploration

Morning

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before setting out to explore the iconic Angkor Archaeological Park by tuk-tuk.

Your first stop is **Angkor Thom**, the final capital of the Khmer Empire under King Jayavarman VII. Enter through the impressive South Gate, known for its towering stone faces and detailed carvings of elephants.



Continue to the famous [Bayon Temple](#), where 54 towers feature the iconic smiling stone faces of Avalokiteshvara looking out in all directions. Nearby, explore the **Terrace of the Elephants** and the **Terrace of the Leper King**, both known for their detailed stone bas-reliefs.

You'll also walk through the former royal grounds and visit smaller hidden temples within the complex. Depending on the season and the crowds, you may also explore [Ta Prohm](#), the jungle-covered temple made famous by Tomb Raider, or the atmospheric **Preah Khan Temple**, a quieter, maze-like ruin with fewer crowds.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant in Siem Reap before returning to your hotel for a short break.

Afternoon

Head out by private vehicle to the surrounding countryside for a more local, off-the-beaten-path experience.

Visit a **local market** where you'll get a chance to practice basic Khmer greetings and observe daily trading life. Continue to **Phnom Bok Mountain**, where you'll climb over 600 steps to reach the summit, rewarded with panoramic countryside views.



At the top, enjoy a short Khmer language introduction with your local guide and explore the remains of an ancient pagoda. After descending, relax with fresh coconut and continue practicing simple local phrases.

On the way back, pass through rural villages and rice fields for a glimpse of everyday Cambodian life. End the day at a lively evening street market near town before returning to your hotel for a rest.

Note: This tour includes a steep climb of over 600 steps and requires a good general fitness level.

Day 3 - 4 : Siem Reap Free Day

Enjoy two full days at your own pace in Siem Reap, with the freedom to relax or choose from a range of exciting optional activities. This is your time to explore beyond the temples and add a bit more adventure to your Cambodia vacation.

Day 5: Siem Reap – Battambang

Morning

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, check out, and set off on a scenic 3-hour drive to Battambang, Cambodia's second-largest city and the country's leading rice-producing region.

Upon arrival, check in at your hotel and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

Afternoon

Begin your Battambang exploration with a visit to **Ek Phnom Temple**, an 11th-century ruin featuring remnants of Buddha statues and detailed Naga carvings. Continue along the **Sangke River**, where you'll see charming colonial-style architecture that reflects the city's French heritage.

On the way back, stop by traditional Cambodian houses and a local artisan workshop producing rice paper and flaky rice cakes. In the late afternoon, enjoy one of Battambang's most unique experiences - the **Bamboo Train** - a fun ride through the countryside with beautiful sunset views.



Evening

Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before returning to your hotel for a relaxing evening.

Day 6: Battambang - Cycling Tour & Bat Cave Discovery

Morning

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel and get ready for an active day ahead, with departure around **8:00 AM**.

You'll be picked up by tuk-tuk and transferred to the bike office for a short safety briefing and bike fitting before starting your cycling adventure.

Ride through the countryside of northern Battambang and experience authentic local village life up close. Along the route, you'll see traditional cottage industries and local spiritual sites, with opportunities to see and taste local products such as rice noodles, bamboo sticky rice, rice paper, dried banana snacks, rice wine, and more, include **Wat Samrong Knong** (Buddhist pagoda), a local fish paste market, and a crocodile farm.



Your local guide will share insights along the way, helping you better understand daily life in rural Cambodia. Around midday, cycle back to the bike office and transfer to your hotel for lunch and a short break.

Afternoon

After recharging, continue your journey west along Road 57 to **Phnom Sampov (Bat Cave)**, a natural and cultural landmark crowned by a hilltop pagoda.

NOTE: *Optional motorbike transfer is available (surcharge) for easier access to the top.*



Explore the caves, each with its own history and stories, while also keeping an eye out for the resident monkeys. From the base of the mountain, prepare for the highlight of the visit—thousands of bats emerging from the cave at sunset, creating a truly unforgettable natural spectacle.

Evening

After the Bat Cave experience, return to your hotel in Battambang. The rest of the evening is free at your leisure.

Day 7: Battambang - Phnom Penh

Morning

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, check out early, and begin your journey toward Phnom Penh.

En route, stop in **Kampong Chhnang**, a riverside province known for its traditional pottery villages and local rice wine production. This is a great opportunity to see how rural crafts are made and experience authentic Cambodian village life.



Continue to **Oudong**, passing scenic countryside views, small villages, and roadside pagodas along the way. Upon arrival, enjoy a traditional Khmer-style picnic lunch at the base of the mountain.

Afternoon

Hike up **Oudong Mountain**, once a former royal capital, and take in panoramic views of the surrounding plains and countryside. Your guide will share insights into Cambodia's royal history, religious traditions, and cultural heritage as you explore the ancient stupas at the summit.



After the visit, continue by road to Phnom Penh (approximately 1 hour). Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure to start discovering Cambodia's capital city.

Day 8: Phnom Penh – Cycling & City Tour

Morning

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel before starting a cycling adventure outside Phnom Penh.

Take a ferry to **Koh Dach** and ride along quiet, traffic-free village roads. Explore the peaceful countryside, passing small communities, local schools, and traditional silk-weaving workshops. This is a great way to experience everyday rural life just outside the capital.



Return to Phnom Penh by vehicle and enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

Afternoon

Continue your city tour in Phnom Penh, beginning with the [Royal Palace](#), home to Cambodia's royal heritage and a stunning collection of Buddha statues crafted from gold, silver, crystal, and bronze.



Next, visit the **National Museum**, a beautiful traditional Khmer-style building showcasing one of the world's finest collections of ancient Khmer art, sculpture, and religious artifacts dating from the 4th to 13th centuries.

After your visits, return to your hotel and enjoy your final evening in Phnom Penh at leisure.

Day 9: Phnom Penh – Departure

Enjoy your final breakfast in Phnom Penh and take some time to relax or enjoy last-minute leisure before check-out. At the scheduled time, your driver will transfer you to the airport for your departure flight.
