### Day 1: Arrive Hanoi & Puppet Show

Watch as wooden puppets glide and dance across the shimmering surface, animated by skilled puppeteers hidden behind a bamboo screen. Accompanied by live folk music and rhythmic drumming, the show will captivate both adults and children alike.



As the sun sets over the city's lakes and colonial rooftops, enjoy your first evening in Hanoi at your own pace - perhaps sampling local cuisine or strolling through the lantern-lit streets of the Old Quarter, where vibrant street life sets the tone for the exciting days ahead.

Its intricate carvings and serene setting make it a memorable stop for visitors of all ages.

Continue on to one of Hanoi’s most revered sites: the [Temple of Literature](#) - Vietnam’s first national university, founded in 1070. Dedicated to Confucius, this peaceful complex of courtyards, gardens, and ancient stone stelae is where generations of scholars once gathered to pursue knowledge and wisdom. Stroll under the archways, listen to the echoes of scholarly footsteps, and pose for photos amid traditional Vietnamese architecture.

Explore hidden chambers, camouflaged trapdoors, and Hoang Cam's smokeless kitchen, where meals were prepared without revealing smoke to the enemy.

For those seeking extra adventure, you have the unique opportunity to try AK-47 shooting with real bullets at a designated range (optional activity, with payment on-site). Before leaving, sample boiled tapioca and hot tea - a simple meal that once sustained soldiers, offering a taste of wartime reality.



At **17:30**, your driver returns you to your hotel in Ho Chi Minh City, leaving you with unforgettable memories of history, cuisine, and countryside life.

## Day 10: Ho Chi Minh City - Mekong Delta - Tan Phong Island

### Morning

Upon arrival at the Cai Be tourist pier, board your traditional wooden boat operated by Mekong Ecolodge, ready to cruise through a world shaped by rivers and canals.

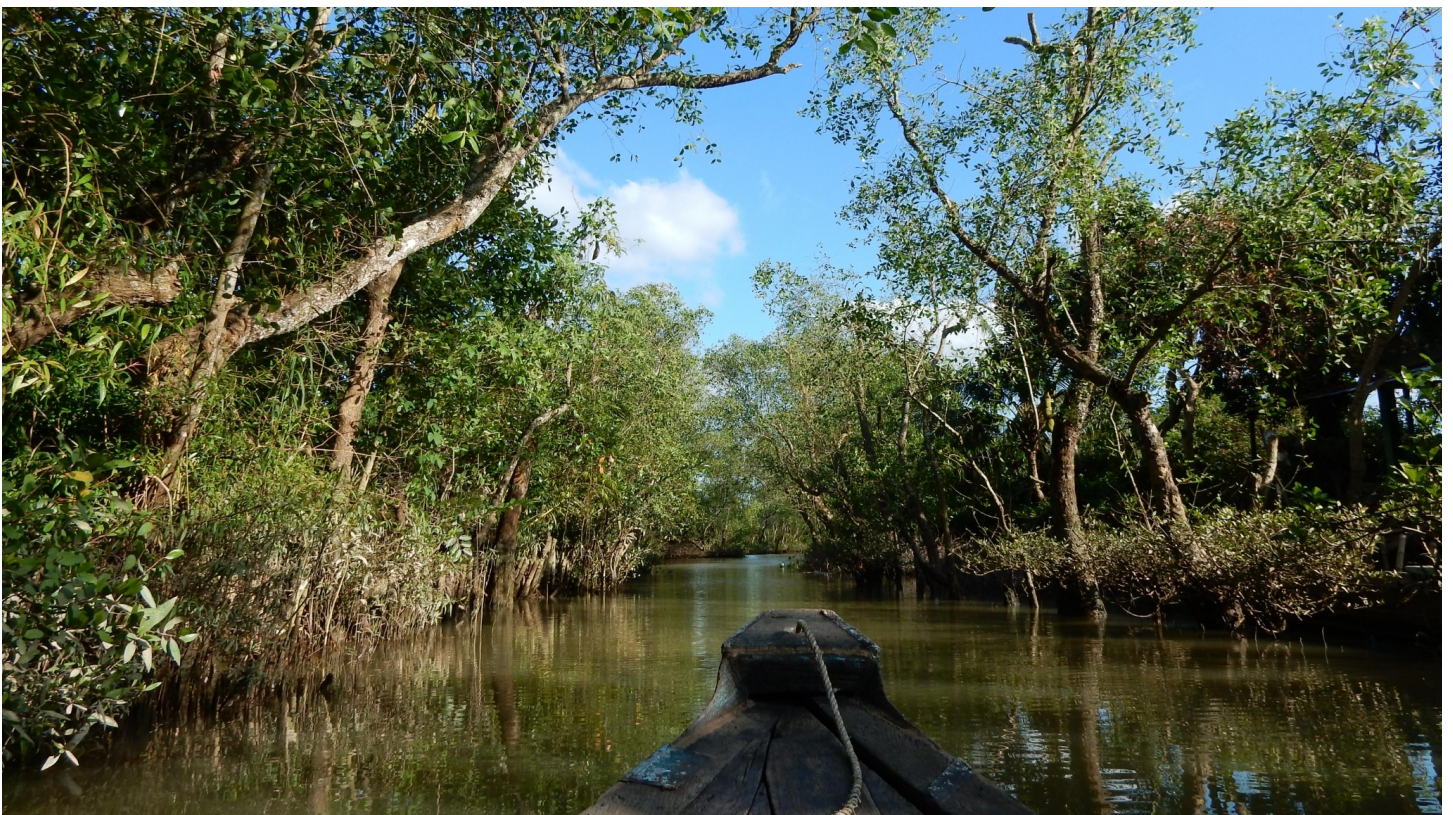

At a traditional garden home, you'll be treated to a folk music exchange, where the melodic notes of southern Vietnamese instruments float on the breeze. Enjoy a cup of tea and a plate of fresh tropical fruit as you enjoy the performance.



Next, hop into a small boat for a peaceful ride through the narrow, tree-shaded canals that weave across Tan Phong Island.

After disembarking, check in at the charming **Mekong Ecolodge**, where a delicious lunch awaits and a comfortable room offers you a tranquil place to rest.

### **Afternoon**

Explore the ecolodge's lush grounds - wander through colorful flower gardens, pick fruits straight from the trees, and take in the rhythms of delta life.

Then, at around **16:00**, join a local guide in the fun and muddy tradition of "slapping the ditch" to catch fish, just like the farmers do. You'll also gather herbs and vegetables from the garden, all of which will be used in your evening meal.

## **Day 11: Tan Phong Island - Ho Chi Minh City**

Watch as rice batter is spread thin on bamboo mats and steamed into translucent sheets. Next, discover the rare and fascinating art of hammock weaving using banana rope, and even try weaving a portion of your own under the guidance of a local expert.



Continue on to a welcoming village home, where you'll explore the craft of **water hyacinth weaving** - a sustainable practice that transforms a common plant into beautiful, eco-friendly baskets, mats, and accessories. Under your host's careful instruction, create your own small souvenir to bring home.

Then, learn about the fine art of crafting **bamboo nail files**, a clever example of how local communities creatively use available natural materials.

The morning wraps up with a delightful cooking activity centered on **jackfruit leaf cakes**, a traditional Mekong treat with a soft, chewy texture and subtly sweet flavor. As you prepare the cakes with your host, you'll not only learn the recipe but also enjoy the fruits of your labor in a light, homemade tasting session.

### Afternoon

At **12:00**, bid farewell to the gentle rhythms of Tan Phong Island and board the ferry to **Hiep Duc**, where your transfer awaits.

Sit back and relax during the drive back to Ho Chi Minh City, returning to the energy of Vietnam's southern hub filled with unforgettable memories of the Mekong's warmth and hospitality.

## Day 12: Flight to Siem Reap, Angkor Wat Sunset

### Morning

### Day 13: Kampong Phluk - Tonle Sap River Boat Cruise & Dinner Show

This remarkable community rests atop towering stilts, 8 to 10 meters high, rising dramatically above the floodwaters of the **Tonle Sap Lake** - Southeast Asia's largest freshwater lake and one of the richest ecosystems in the region.

Upon arrival, board a traditional wooden boat and glide slowly through the labyrinth of stilted homes, where entire lives unfold above the water.

As you cruise deeper into the flooded mangrove forests, observe the stillness of nature and listen for the calls of water birds that thrive in this lush habitat. The area is home to over a hundred species of freshwater fish and countless birds, making it a vital sanctuary for both people and wildlife.

After the cruise, return to **Siem Reap** for a short rest at your hotel.

#### Evening

In the evening, gather for a vibrant **dinner show**, where classical Apsara dancers in ornate silk costumes perform graceful movements that tell ancient stories of love, legends, and Khmer heritage.

Savor a flavorful meal of Cambodian delicacies as music and dance bring the culture of the kingdom to life - an unforgettable farewell to your Southeast Asia journey.
