: Low Water Program (From Mid-November to End-August)

Day 1: Siem Reap - Stueng Trang - Kampong Cham

Morning

First of the journey, you are welcomed to the lounge in Siem Reap.

Upon boarding, the crew warmly welcomes guests, guiding them to their staterooms before a welcome buffet lunch. After settling in, the cruise director hosts a safety and orientation briefing.

Afternoon & Evening

In the afternoon, a bus excursion takes us to [Kampong Cham](#), a vital trade hub surrounded by rural hamlets where artisans craft food, fashion, and household goods. A highlight is the seasonal Bamboo Bridge, a passageway steeped in tradition.

As the sun sets, we sail toward Angkor Ban for our overnight mooring. Guests mingle over prosecco and canapés during a welcome gathering at the bar, with the Mekong as a stunning backdrop.

After dinner, the onboard cinema screens a classic film or documentary to round off the evening.

Day 2: Angkor Ban - Prek Bangkok

Morning

Start your morning with a refreshing Tai Chi session before venturing into the delightful village of **Angkor Ban**. This hidden gem is home to a serene monastery and a warm local community.

You can meet monks during their morning lessons, stroll through the village lanes, and enjoy genuine encounters with residents, offering a glimpse into Cambodia's timeless rural life.

Afternoon & Evening

As the ship cruises downstream toward Phnom Penh, we pause at **Prek Bangkok**, a village celebrated for its silk-weaving tradition and once the residence of the Royal family. Witness the meticulous art of silk production and step inside the heritage home of H.E. Sam-EI, a distinguished royal architect.

Back on board, savor a refined multi-course dinner before unwinding with an evening film screening, as the vessel moors midstream on the Tonle River with the glittering Phnom Penh skyline as your backdrop.

Day 3: Kampong Laeang - Kampong Tralach - Phnom Penh

Morning

Set out to explore **Kampong Laeang**, a riverside village lying opposite the famed pottery hub of Kampong Chhnang. A tuk-tuk ride takes you into the heart of rural Cambodian life, where you can meet locals, watch

skilled artisans shaping pottery, and step inside a charming pre-Angkorian temple.

From a scenic viewpoint, admire sweeping vistas of the floodplains and verdant rice fields (seasonal).

As the vessel glides southward toward **Kampong Tralach**, enjoy lunch on board with stunning views of the Tonle River.

Afternoon & Evening

Later, afternoon tea is served before setting out on another countryside adventure. Travel by ox cart along winding paths framed by rice paddies to reach a quaint village. Here, you may visit a local NGO school and library project or explore an ancient 300-year-old temple with a sacred Buddha shrine.

Back on board, indulge in a multi-course dinner before relaxing with a film at the evening cinema. By nightfall, the ship sails farther down the Tonle River, eventually mooring midstream opposite Phnom Penh, with the city's dazzling skyline shimmering across the water.

Day 4: Phnom Penh City Tour

Morning

Welcome us to Phnom Penh, with its remarkable history and unique culture. You can begin sightseeing the city for a full day right after breakfast.

Following our guide to learn more about the city's highlights. We start our tour by taking a cyclo ride through the town, discovering historical sites like the **Royal Palace** and the **Silver Pagoda**.

Our trip will take us to the **S21 Prison**, which contains an emotional and somber period in Cambodia's past during the Khmer Rouge regime of the 1970s.

Afternoon & Evening

Afterward, we'll pause for a delightful lunch in town before visiting a famous academy of arts and a school dedicated to preserving traditional arts. Observe young dancers training in the intricate Apsara dance and take the opportunity to learn some basic techniques on your own under guidance.

Then, we will stroll through the city's French quarter leisurely, as well as the iconic and aptly named monument of [Wat Phnom](#).

Savor a delightful open-air barbecue followed by a gala dinner, in harmony with a traditional Apsara dance performance to conclude this memorable day.

The rest of the day, we are free to stroll around the city at night, enjoy the lovely nightlife of Phnom Penh, or walk along the river shore.

Day 1: Siem Reap - Tonle Lake

Morning

Welcome to the lounge in Siem Reap, where we will meet together for the trip. Sip a cup of coffee this morning, then travel to the pier by bus.

Farewell to the unique scene of Angkor and depart for the shore of Tonle Lake. A local boat transports you to the vessel, your luxurious "home" for the upcoming days.

We have lunch on the cruise glide over [Tonle Lake](#): the Tonle Sap. In the wet season, the lake will be longer than it is in the dry season, so let your soul relax while the boat is floating across the lake.

Afternoon & Evening

Simply enjoy time aboard until our cruise director invites you to a little afternoon sunset event with canapés and prosecco, where one can socialise with other fellow passengers.

Before dinner, our expert guide holds a presentation about the geography of the Mekong River and Tonle Lake in the lounge. If you are in the mood, join in for the nightly cinema before retiring to your room.

Day 2: Kampong Laeang - Kampong Tralach - Kampong Cham

Morning

Departing from the midst of the vast Tonle region, we continue to travel to **Kampong Laeang** in the morning. This location lies across from the populated town of Kampong Chhnang, one of Cambodia's most comfortable ecosystems.

Upon arrival, we will board a tuk-tuk to discover the heart of Cambodia's countryside and investigate the skillful art of craft pottery. As well as discovering the pre-Angkorian temple

We go back to the cruise for lunch while sailing South to **Kampong Tralach**. Enjoy the yummy lunch and take in the natural scenery of the Tonle River.

Afternoon & Evening

In a small village, you will have a chance to know more about local NGO schools, which improve access to quality education in rural areas. Or you can choose to take a look at the nearby ancient 300-year-old temple and Buddha Shrine.

After sightseeing, we attended a fashion Show offered onboard in the early evening. The ship will continue the journey across the Mekong River overnight.

Day 3: Prek Bangkong - Angkor Ban - Phnom Penh

Morning

Awake to a refreshing Tai Chi session for early risers as the scenery transforms entirely, we are now in the wide expanse of the Mekong.

Our morning excursion takes us to the riverside village of **Prek Bangkong**, once the residence of Cambodia's Royal family before they moved to the palace.

Today, the village is best known for its skilled silk weavers, artisans who create this luxurious fabric from start to finish. We'll observe their meticulous craft and then step inside the heritage home of H.E. Sam-EI, a

distinguished royal architect.

Afternoon & Evening

Back on board, the ship continues upstream to **Angkor Ban**. This charming village is home to a monastery and a welcoming community. Guests can meet monks during their morning lessons and share warm exchanges with villagers.

Later, a gentle walk through the settlement reveals the rhythms of rural life, offering touching encounters and countless photo opportunities that capture Cambodia's authentic spirit.

Later, we sail a short way downstream to **Phnom Penh**, where the ship anchors midstream, presenting sweeping views of the capital's skyline.

Day 4: Phnom Penh City Tour

Morning

Our trip will drive us to the "**S21**" prison, also known as [the Toul Sleng Genocide Museum](#), which contains an emotional and somber period in Cambodia's past during the Khmer Rouge regime of the 1970s. Afterward, enjoy a delicious lunch in town before delving deeper into Khmer traditions.

Afternoon & Evening

The afternoon begins with a visit to a renowned academy of arts, where efforts are devoted to safeguarding Cambodia's cultural heritage. Watch young performers practicing the graceful Apsara dance and even try a few of the elegant movements yourself under the guidance of the instructors.

We continuously stroll through the city's French quarter leisurely, as well as the iconic and aptly named monument of **Wat Phnom**.

For the rest of the day, we have the freedom to leisurely explore the city, admiring the charming nightlife of Phnom Penh or taking a stroll along the riverbanks.
